Policy:

EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES (Equity – EEdO)



Rationale:

The Ministry of Education's vision is that every child will enjoy high quality education that enables them to participate and contribute socially and economically.

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines that ensure opportunities to succeed are provided for all students regardless of socio-economic background, ethnicity, disability, religion, family background or other barrier.

Definitions:

EEdO – Equal Educational Opportunities

EEO - Equal Employment Opportunities

Scope:

This policy applies to all students.

Guidelines:

- 1. The Board of Trustees will encourage and support diversity in its staffing mix to meet the diverse needs, backgrounds and abilities of students.
- 2. The school's EEO programme will contribute positively to the EEdO of students, particularly through informing staff appointments, performance and morale.
- 3. The curriculum will be presented in a culturally responsive way.
- 4. Staff will be encouraged to learn and use Te Reo Maori.
